Professor Uzzell is obviously very passionate and knowledgable about this topic and the contents of the course. The outline for the convention aspect of the course was confusing at first, but later felt very reasonable. The workload, at times, felt very constant and very dense, but that was partially due to our small class size, which was out of her control. Overall, this class has made me a much better writer and more confident public speaker.

I think that the first half of the semester that involves only lecture could be adjusted slightly to make it more interesting and engaging. The lecture period was definitely necessary and the material important, but it could become very monotonous at times. I recommend one extra class period to go over the specifics of the convention and speeches just so the delegates aren't thrown into it blindly the first week. Overall, I found this class very challenging but very rewarding at the same time. It was a struggle to adjust to the unconventional way of learning in the beginning but now I can't imagine a better way to fully grasp the making of the Constitution and the end product without having lived it myself. This was one of my favorite classes this semester.

I absolutely loved this class. If Prof. Uzzell taught more classes that I could fit into my schedule, I would sign up immediately. She is astonishingly knowledgeable about the Constitution and its history. She has been far and away, my favorite professor this year. If this school has any sense at all, they will keep her around for as long as possible.

I found the course to be incredibly fun and an excellent way to learn about the Constitution and the Convention. The only things I would perhaps change would be to return to only playing one character — playing two made compromise more difficult and made it harder to represent the interests of the character that you're playing. I also would say that it may be wise to hide the victory objectives from the players until the end, as knowing exactly what needs passed makes compromise less likely. If it's clear what the characters want and what they will and won't settle for, it's the same thing as the victory objectives, but allows a more honest game with a little more wiggle room for compromise.

Professor Uzzell was absolutely wonderful this semester. This has been undoubtably one of the most fun classes I have ever been a part of.

Professor Uzzell is extremely knowledgable on the subject matter. So much so that at times it is somewhat difficult to fully meet her expectations. However, she is always willing to help if you go to her office hours and she gives thorough feedback on all papers.
